SPIRIT OF THE 60s

Ten decades over two centuries cover the existence of what is now the Bristol Motor Club. In 1911, cars were still something of a rarity: big, heavy, and driven more often by paid chauffeurs than by their wealthy owners. But one night in November, sixteen tweed-clad motorcyclists gathered at the Royal Talbot Hotel Bristol with one aim: to form a club to help further the enjoyment of their machines, and thus the Bristol Motor Cycle Club came into being. They were soon organising sporting competitions which even in those early days were all about testing their machines, either to see how fast they would go on a speed trial, or proving their endurance over many miles in a reliability trial.

The rest of that decade was overshadowed by the 1914-18 War, after which it became clear that the motor car was going to be the vehicle of the masses, and in 1922 the club altered its name to The Bristol Motor Cycle & Light Car Club.

The highest-profile decade in the Club's history was probably the 1950s, when we converted the WWII airfield at Castle Combe into a race circuit. For five years from 1950 the club held three meetings annually, attracting entries from Lotus, Cooper, Connaught and BRM, with famous names like Stirling Moss, Mike Hawthorn, Peter Collins, Roy Salvadori, Colin Chapman and Bob Gerard drawing in crowds of 12,000 or more.

The 1960s brought the club's next exciting venture, the speed hillclimb here at Dyrham Park, the event that we are celebrating today. From 1961 to 1966 there were three events each year, including rounds of the national British Hillclimb Championship. It had a large and enthusiastic following, but by 1966 the National Trust, under pressure from its members, decided to call time on motorsport at Dyrham, and so came to a sad end an event that is still fondly remembered by drivers and spectators alike.

Which brings us to 2011. We are celebrating a three-way anniversary this year: it's 50 years since the National Trust took over Dyrham Park, it's 50 years since Bristol Motor Club first ran the speed hillclimb here and, as I've already said, it's our Centenary Year.

We are very grateful to the National Trust for inviting us back here today, and we are delighted to welcome so many cars and people who are being reunited both with each other and with the beautiful surroundings of Dyrham Park. I hope you will enjoy wandering amongst the cars, talking to the drivers and sharing their memories of the 1960s speed hillclimb, and of course revelling once again in the sight and sound of Motorsport in the Park in 2011!
